

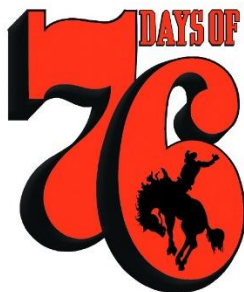


***Miss Days of '76 Queen Contest
Monday, July 22, 2019 --- Deadwood, SD.***

Young ladies who are residents of the state of South Dakota, or attend school in South Dakota, age 26 and younger are invited to enter the tenth annual Days of '76 Queen Contest. The age divisions this year will be: Senior--age 18 to 26 / Junior--age 13 to 17 / Princess --age 12 & under. The contest is sponsored by the Days of '76 PRCA Rodeo Committee. All of the events of the contest will be held on Monday. The new reigning Queens will be required to attend the parades on Friday & Saturday, & help @ each rodeo performance. The Queens will also be required to visit sponsors when asked, participate in social functions when invited, & help @ the 2019 Days of '76 Rodeo activities up to the 2020 Queen Coronation. If the Senior Queen is of age for the Miss Rodeo USA Pageant during her reign, the committee will sponsor her in said pageant. It is desired that reigning Queens wear their Days of '76 title proudly & graciously in parades, at other Rodeo functions, & at community events to best represent The Days of '76 PRCA Rodeo. If it is deemed by the committee that reigning Queen is not representing the Days of 76' PRCA Rodeo with dignity & honor the committee has the power to relinquish her title and retract all of her awards.

2019 Prizes: Sr & Jr Queen will receive Trophy Running P Saddles; Sr, Jr, & Princess will receive Trophy Maynard Buckles; Sr & Jr traveling tiaras; Princess traveling tiara; Sr & Jr traveling chaps; Sr, Jr, Princess Banners; Room for Sr Queen lodging; flowers; Tack for Horsemanship winners; contestant gifts; gifts for winner of photogenics, 1st runner-up, 2nd runner-up, Miss Congeniality.

All of the contest will be held on Monday July 22, 2019, with the Coronation to be held on Tuesday July 23, 2019 at approximately 12:30 pm between the break in the steer roping.

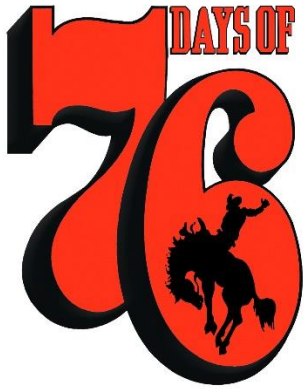

Miss Days of 76' Queen Contest

July 22, 2019—Deadwood, SD

CONTEST INFORMATION:

CLOTHES—At Check in, Orientation, & for Photogenics you will wear a **“FASHION FORWARD” OUTFIT**...which is a trendy, fun, party attire type outfit. It must have at least cap sleeves or longer, skirt/dress no shorter than 3” above knees/or leggings/slacks, western boots, western hat, western belt with trophy buckle.

---At **MODELING & IMPROMPTU SPEAKING**—wear a long formal “western” dress.

---At **INTERVIEWS**—wear an interview appropriate outfit. [SUIT JACKET & SLACKS or SKIRT].

---At **HORSEMANSHIP**—wear a Horsemanship outfit-colored blouse & colored jeans.

---At **CORONATION**—Arena blouse & jeans of your choice, or use your horsemanship outfit.

1. **PHOTOGENICS SHOOT:** Check in & then go to private photo shoot. You must pose yourself to your best advantage. The photographer will not help you. You will have a standing shot, a setting shot, & an action /fun shot. 2 of each.
2. **ORIENTATION:** Be prepared to briefly introduce yourself [with: example-- “Hello my name is Susie Smith, a sr contestant from Deadwood, SD”} nothing else...then briefly introduce your guests. Each age group starting with the seniors will model their Fashion Forward outfit individually while their short bio is read. You will then answer 2 questions. And then your group will model through the crowd & line up for photos. [Srs will be excused first to go change into long formal dress.]
3. **MODELING & IMPROMPTU SPEAKING:** You will be called on stage to model individually while your dress description is being read. Then you will give your impromptu speech on a topic which was given to you prior. [with no time limit—but judges will score accordingly for a short talk less than one minute.] At the end, each group will model through the crowd & line up for photos. Seniors excused first to change into Interview outfit.
4. **PUBLIC MEDIA INTERVIEW:** [wearing Interview outfit]—Each girl will go before the judges & audience, while the other contestants are in a secluded room off stage. You will be asked 3 or 4 questions by the Judges. Then you will be seated and the next contestant will come out and answer the same questions. You should be versed on the Days of 76' History, Historical Characters of Deadwood, & general Rodeo & SD knowledge. When finished the whole group will line up for photos.
5. **INTERVIEW:** Personal Interviews individually in private with the Judges.

- 6. HORSEMANSHIP:** There will be at least an hour or more break before horsemanship to give you time to change clothes and get your horse warmed up. You will bring your own horse for this. A set pattern will be emailed to you. Sr.-Jr. –You may be asked to dis-mount & mount your horse, carry a flag, or do additional pattern work -at the discretion of the judges. You may use western tack of your choice-but it will be checked by the judges-they will prefer to follow AQHA reining guidelines. You must use split reins, no riding two handed. Spurs are optional. As horsemanship skills are a big part of rodeo and the equine industry, in depth Horsemanship questions will be asked.
- 7. CORONATION:** Be horseback at the arena on Tuesday July 23 approximately noon—at the break in the steer roping.

The new 2019 reigning Miss Days of 76' PRCA Rodeo Senior & Junior Queens will be required to stay & help @ all of the 2019 rodeo performances, & ride in the parades on Friday & Saturday. A room will be sponsored for the Senior & Junior Queens. They will also be required to help through-out the year & up into July 2020 with the Days of 76' Rodeo queen contest on Monday & coronation on Tuesday of 2020. The committee will work with the queen's school & travel schedule & take that into consideration when asking the queens to be at events. The committee will work closely with the Queens in getting them scheduled to appear at some of Deadwood's most prestigious & important promotional events through out the year. The committee will work hard to offer a very memorable and rewarding year for the reigning Days of 76' PRCA Rodeo Queens. We hope young ladies from across the state will take advantage of this great rodeo opportunity.

If the Senior queen is under age 21 a parent must stay in the room with her and be responsible for her care.

The Junior Queen must stay with her parents in her room. Her family will be responsible for her care.

PRINCESS CONTEST: THE Princess contestants will go through the same events: Check In, Photogenics Shoot, Orientation, Fashion Forward, Modeling & Impromptu Speaking, Public Media Interview, Personal Interview, Horsemanship, Coronation---but it will be geared down to their age appropriate level. The winning Princess will not help in the arena, but may stay and ride in the parades if her horse is parade safe, or we will have her ride in a wagon. The Princess is invited to go to the autograph sessions, but it is not mandatory for her. Her family will be responsible for her at all times, and for her room.
